Chrysa Theologou studied at the Department of Greek Philology of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (Greece). From the same Department she received the Master's degree in Modern Greek Literature, with the grade "Excellent". In 2022 she was awarded a Doctorate in the Department of Philology, Faculty of Philosophy, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, (title of doctoral thesis: "The book reviews of *Nea Hestia* magazine, 1927-1987"). She has worked as a research associate at the Centre for the Greek Language during the period 2012-2015 and during the academic year 2022-2023 she was a lecturer at the Department of Philology of the University of Ioannina, in the framework of the programme "Acquisition of academic experience for young researchers holding a PhD".
